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How Do I Access My Avast Account?

Accessing your Avast account allows you to manage your Avast products, subscriptions, devices, and account information in one place. Whether you use Avast for antivirus protection, privacy, performance, or other security features, signing in gives you access to the services connected to your account.

Open Your Avast Account

Forgot Your Avast Password?

If you cannot remember your Avast password, use the password recovery option available on the sign-in screen.

If you cannot find the message, check your spam or junk folder.

After creating a new password, return to the Avast sign-in page and use the new password to access your account.

Choose a strong and unique password and avoid using the same password for other important accounts.

Your Subscription Is Not Showing

If you can sign in successfully but cannot find your Avast subscription, check the email address associated with your account.

Your subscription may have been purchased or activated using another email address.

Review your account details and compare the email address with the one used during your original purchase.

If you have multiple Avast products, make sure you are checking the account associated with the correct product.

Avoid creating a new account until you have confirmed that your existing account does not contain the subscription you are looking for.

Troubleshoot Avast Login Problems

If Avast does not accept your login information, carefully check your email address and password.

Make sure there are no spelling errors.

Check the capitalization of your password and make sure Caps Lock is not enabled accidentally.

If your browser automatically fills in your password, try entering it manually.

You can also restart your browser and attempt to sign in again.

If the login page does not work properly, try using a private browsing window or another browser.

Check Your Internet Connection

A stable internet connection can help prevent account access problems.

If the Avast login page does not load, check whether other websites are working normally.

Restart your internet connection if necessary and try again.

If you are using the Avast application, restarting the application or your device may also resolve temporary issues.

Keeping your browser and Avast software updated can help prevent compatibility problems.

Check Your Account After Login

Check your account email address.

Use a strong and unique password.

Never share your password with other people.

Do not enter your login information on suspicious websites.

Be cautious with unexpected messages requesting your Avast account details.

Keep your Avast application, browser, and operating system updated.

Use additional security features when available to provide extra protection.

When to Contact Support
